MOTORHOME TRAVELLERS CHECK LIST

- Turn Off Gas Cylinder/s Outside.
- Check external Lockers are shut and Locked.
- Shut and Lock Roof-Lights. Including in the Shower room.
- Check the Shower door is secured.
- Stow away your Hook-up Cables.
- Retract the Door Step/s.
- Fasten all Windows securely.
- Turn your Fridge to the Battery sign.
- Check Fridge door is securely shut.
- Check Internal Lockers are secured.
- Turn Off Internal Water Heating.
- Turn Off Internal Heating.
- All passengers must travel with seat belts.
- All children must travel with booster seats or child seats as appropriate.
- Check that nothing can 'fly off' a high bed or shelf that could hurt a passenger in the event of an accident.

- Avoid low bridges. Check that the route does not involve low bridges.
- Avoid grass verges. A heavy vehicle may not be able to get off a soft grass verge.
- Avoid overhanging trees, hedges and bushes. These can puncture and scratch the vehicle.
- Avoid overhanging and low street lighting or house roves/eaves.
- Note that other vehicles may not be able to judge the size of your vehicle, so drive carefully and park wisely.
- Reversing can be easier with the help of a passenger to help guide you back. The passenger should take care while helping. Also remember it is still the drivers responsibility if the vehicle hits and damages someone or something.
- It is a good idea to be a member of an automobile association with relay cover in the event of a breakdown.
- Remember your Warranty Booklet. This will help you in the case of a mechanical breakdown. There is a process that must be adhered to.

If you insure through Safeguard, AA cover is included. You need to check that the cover includes 'relay'
